### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

Felt making is an ancient craft dating back to Neolithic times. Wet felting applications and processes can be tracked through all cultures. In this class, the students will learn wet felting by making a one of a kind purse which may be embellished at a later time using any technique desired. Next, students will explore needle or dry felting by creating a sea gull, which will open the students minds to other possibilities.
