COURSE DESCRIPTION

This little project is composed of three separate pieces: a scissors fob, a small frame weight, and sampler needle and pin roll. The sampler needle and pin roll has a padded pocket that serves as a pin holder and holder for thread winder or small skein. All three items are with the same colors of thread and a variety of stitches. If desired, the sampler does fit into the Olds Colonial mini burl clock frame.

Although she loves all needlework, her focus is on counted thread techniques and counted canvas designs.
