### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

Let's spend the day together stitching a little roll to hold our precious scissors. With a bit of basting before class we will explore a variety of counted thread stitches. The scissors roll is designed to hold 3 pairs of scissors or a combination of fine scissors, hemostats and metal or paper scissors. When stitched and finished, the scissors fit inside of 3 pockets and are held in place with small magnets. The finished project measures 7 ½" by 4 ½" when open. The roll has three wide floral bands and two narrow bands on the outside plus the three inside pockets with a place to stitch your initials. The stitcher has the choice of three color ways, rose and green, coral and green or blue and green. The model is stitched with Anchor floss on 32 count Lambswool linen, and size 12 Anchor perle cotton.

**Color Choices:** Coral/Green, Rose/Green, Blue/Green
