COURSE DESCRIPTION

A mystery necklace! This class promises to be an adventure in learning, as many unique elements are created for this beautiful surprise necklace. A colorful detached leaf, flower or fringe will be presented and stitched about every 1½ hours during the two days. The finished necklace will not be revealed until the last afternoon of the class. The necklace strap of triangle beads will be started in class. Students will learn to attach the various elements to the necklace in class. This is an excellent class for experienced beaders to experiment with some new detached techniques and have a wonderful necklace to take home.

Technique: Beading—Herringbone stitch; peyote stitch; brick stitch; leaf and daisy stitches

Carolyn Sherman of Colorado Springs, Colorado, has taught beading and clothing embellishment techniques at many needlework seminars and quilting conferences. These include *International Quilt Festival* in Houston, TX and *The Bead and Button Show* in Milwaukee, WI. She has taught at eight EGA and ANG national seminars as well as numerous EGA region seminars. Carolyn was inducted into the Colorado Quilting Council's Hall of Fame in 1991, and received the EGA Rocky Mountain Region "Educators' Award for Excellence" in 2001. Her quilted landscape of Garden of the Gods was pictured on the back cover of the September 1995 issue of *Needle Arts* and she was the "Designer Across America" in the summer 2000 issue. Her current love is designing and teaching beaded boxes and dimensional jewelry.
