COURSE DESCRIPTION

The custom embroidery class, what you want to do: a quiet stitching spot or time to listen to what others are doing. It will be time to reconsider a project with a professional, or time to start that idea you have been considering.

Your job is to decide what you want to do then let me know, at least one month before class. There will be a library of books and materials that seem relevant to each project. Then I will triage the request so that each person has personal time.

Students will need to bring basic stitching supplies, all tools, supplies and materials for their project including any instructions or notes plus any lights or stands they use. Bringing one reference book on the topic is strongly suggested.

Susan Dawson is an embroidery judge and teacher, a Master Craftsman, with a BS in Education. She teaches surface techniques and can teach most counted and canvas styles. In three decades Susan has created over 200 original embroideries and many more study pieces using over 100 different embroidery techniques. Her embroidery has been receiving recognition for over twenty years and her designing has expanded beyond embroidery into other textile areas, concrete architecture, garden design and mosaics. Her private library has 2000+ titles and many hundreds of period embroidery samples.
